



How to Link Orders with Research Studies:


- Providers and research staff can associate orders they place with research studies in which the patient is enrolled. Associating an order with a study gives other clinicians a more complete picture of why the order was placed for that patient. However, for **RBR studies it is always recommended to link encounters to the calendar, even if an order is linked to the study.**
- You can click the Research Association button to open the Associate Research Studies window, from which they can select studies for which the patient has an active enrollment status. The button appears only if the patient has an active status for a research study.
- Note that each order can be associated with **only one study**. Please follow the below steps to link the order to a research study.
 1. Add Order with your normal ordering workflow:



2. Click on dropdown arrow next to options:



3. Select 'Research Association'; check on the box to associate the order with the study:



- After associating orders, users can view which orders were associated with studies in the Order Composer as well as in columns in the Order Review and Chart Review activities.
